Activities Presented at the Workshop

- 1. Who do you look up to:** Please talk with your neighbor about a leader you look up to and why. Does anyone want to share? Do you see that you could use this activity in your chapters as an icebreaker? You could apply any topic to the discussion.
- 2. Line Dance, or “Agree or Disagree”:** Listen to some leadership statements and if you strongly agree, please go to the far left corner. If you strongly disagree, please go to the closer left corner. If you are in-between or conflicted, place yourself in that area. Discuss your reasoning with those around you.
- 3. Introduce Your Partner's Non-obvious trait:** It is always fun to find something out about the members that you just don't know.
- 4. Brush with Fame:** Tell your partner (or team) your closest encounter with someone famous
- 5. Scrapbook Activity:** Select a magazine picture from those on your table and try to make it "fit" to some activity or comment you've heard today. Discuss why you chose the picture and how it fits.
- 6. Chalk Talk:** Go to one of the sheets taped to the wall and write down at least one thing you will remember from a presentation at your meeting.
