What We Do

A Legislative Consultant/Advocate is employed by Chi State to inform members, to alert them to action needed, and to speak on our behalf to State legislators.

The Bill Evaluator Program utilizes members to study, analyze, and recommend actions on proposed legislation.

The Adopt-a-Legislator Program strives to improve communication between members and State/Federal legislators by maintaining contact through letters, faxes, e-mails, telephone calls, office visits, and invitations to attend or speak at Chapter and Area meetings.

Legislative Study Sessions held in Sacramento allow members to learn about the Legislative process, be informed of educational issues addressed in current legislation and visit with their legislators.

Chi State provides an opportunity to network with legislators and women's groups by its participation in coalitions interested in education.

Workshops and Interest Sessions are held at Chi State Conventions and at Area Conferences to inform and involve members in the legislative process.

Action Alerts are intended to encourage members to become involved in state public policy issues.

Chi State actively participates in the National Legislative Seminar held in Washington, D.C. each biennium and in the U.S. Forum.
