



Holiday Paper Plate Game (Courtesy of Eta Chapter, Area XII)

Materials: Each person needs a white paper plate and a pen or marker.

Directions: Participants put the paper plate on the top of their head. While someone reads the directions one at a time, the participants draw what is requested while the paper plate is still on their heads. After the game is finished each participant scores their plate according to the scoring rubric given below and prizes are awarded for the best drawings.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw a line for the ground.
2. Draw a snowman.
3. Add eyes, a nose, and a mouth.
4. Add a hat on top of the head.
5. You may add any other details you may want on your snowman.
6. Draw a big tree and a small tree behind the snowman.
7. Add a bird on top of one of the trees.
8. Draw a present under or below one of the trees.
9. Draw snowflakes coming down from the sky.

SCORING RUBRIC

- 2 points if the snowman touches the ground
- 2 points if the circles for the snowman's body connect
- 1 point for each if the eyes, nose, and mouth are where they are supposed to be
- 1 point if the hat is on top of the head
- 1 point for every detail you add to the snowman that is in the correct spot on the snowman
- 1 point for a big tree
- 1 point for a small tree
- 1 point if the bird is on top of one of the trees
- 2 points if the present is under or below the tree

PLEASE NOTE:

This activity can be adapted for use during other holiday periods.



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
