



## Making Connections Activity

### Materials Needed:

3x5 card

paper and pencil

Give each guest or member a piece of paper or 3x5 card.

On a card they are to:

1. Write their name
2. Tell something about themselves that no one else will know.

Example: My elementary choir was once mentioned on the Paul Harvey show.

You collect the cards. Mix the cards and give each one a number.

The guests should each have a paper and pencil.

As you read each clue on the card (do **not** read the name), the guests will write a name next to the corresponding number. (If you know the names ahead of time you can list them, otherwise make sure each guest or member has a nametag.)

Now read the clues again with the answer and listen to the stories. This is a great way to really get to know your members.
