

**PROGRAM IDEA:
EEC Focus: Promoting Educational Excellence
through programs and projects**

Title: Sisters A.C.T. II (Another Call to Team)

Note: This idea is appropriate for a beginning of the year planning meeting or may be incorporated into an informational meeting or an object lesson at orientation, telling about how members share in the work load. The following is designed for a planning meeting but may be easily adapted to an informational or orientation meeting.

Program Purposes: To motivate all Chapter members to work in a small team to facilitate at least one activity per year during a Chapter meeting.

Program Summary: A small group (four to five members) hosts one activity per year, organizing and facilitating that activity. A different group hosts each month.

Program Set-up and Plan: Each member is given a package of ACT II microwave popcorn with a heart card attached labeled "You're the Heart of Act II". Members are asked, "What does popcorn do just before it is going to be served?" It EXPLODES! The Educational Excellence Committee (EEC)/Program Chairman sets up a pre-determined skeletal calendar of events and during the first meeting of the year, a folder is provided for each event. The folder includes a description of the event and a place for a name of the member who will serve as Chairman of that event and lines for four to five other members to help for that event.

Follow-up Activity: The host Chairman and helpers of the month are recognized and thanked for hosting the event.

Materials Needed:

- A package of ACT II Popcorn for each member
- A cut-out heart attached to the bag of popcorn with a red ribbon.
